PACIFIC ZONE SPEEDO LEAGUE - RULES

1. The fee per team will be \$600 for the Fall Speedo League.
2. All players and coaches must be registered with USAWP before participating in any games.
3. Team rosters will be checked for eligibility of each player.
4. Rosters are unlimited but ALL players and coaches must be prepared to show proof of membership to USA Water Polo.
5. Athletes are required to wear the same numbered cap throughout the league weekends.
6. Players are allowed to play in both age groups if age eligible, but players are not permitted to play on two teams within the same age group.
7. Ties will not be played off in league games.
8. Each team must have a QUALIFIED ADULT SCORER & TIMER at the desk for all league games.
9. Quarters will be 6 minutes stop time for all age(s). There shall be 2 time outs per game per team.
10. No player may play in the age group league if they are in high school or equivalent.
11. A maximum of three (3) coaches plus team members on the bench during games.
12. If a coach receives a red card during league play, they are ineligible for their team's next game (team of same age group/gender of game in which they received red card). The removed coach may appeal to the Tournament Committee their removal from the tournament after the minimum game ejection has been served.
